Supporting First Generation College Students

Accessing Disadvantaged Students to Higher Education

- Two thousand counties in China accommodate more than 50% of the country's students.
 Family educational background and living conditions limit disadvantaged students to access higher education.
- Disadvantaged students in counties lack educational resources. They are not given enough guidance on learning methods and test skills.
- Disadvantaged students have very limited chance to expand their horizons and acquire future development guidance. Many of them don't know where their way out is.

Join Us to

Support First Generation College Students

About \$1,470 (RMB 10,000 yuan) will enable a student to become a first generation college student, and \$44,117 (RMB 0.3 million yuan) could support 30 students from a high school to receive scholarships and better educational resources.

Tomorrow-iCAN implements

a charity-supported educational program, helping participants who meet the program requirements to improve their learning conditions, habits, methods, abilities, and motivation. The goal is to make them the family's first generation of college students.



HOW IT WORKS

- Provide scholarships to program students.
- A volunteer mentor team consisting of outstanding university professors and teachers was formed to impart knowledge, motivation, and guidance for future development to students.
- A volunteer team composed of outstanding university students was formed to help students develop learning abilities, test preparation skills, and share experiences.
- Empower leading teachers at the program schools by providing expert lectures and exchange sessions to improve their teaching capabilities.

The Program Has:

- Raised \$2.14 million, together with the local partner.
- Supported over 3,300 students in Henan, Shanxi, Gansu, and Xinjiang.

IT HAS HELPED:

- Over 90% of program students who attended the college entrance exam become the first college students in their families.
- Over 60 program students enroll in universities such as Peking University and Tsinghua University.

WHY THIS PROGRAM?

- We partner with China Friendship Foundation for Peace and Development to safeguard the smooth implementation of the program.
- Volunteer Professor Alice Zhang from Peking University helps moblize top educational resources for students.
- It engages schools to ensure the program provides support to the students who are aspiring and in need.
- G2A continuously monitors and engages in program activities.
- G2A performs risk control review regularly.

- Program students in counties have gained confidence, movitation, skills, and effective learning methods that they most need to access quality higher education and secure a brighter future.
- Program students were greatly encouraged by scholarships and other support, who entered universities and became role models for their families and local communities.
