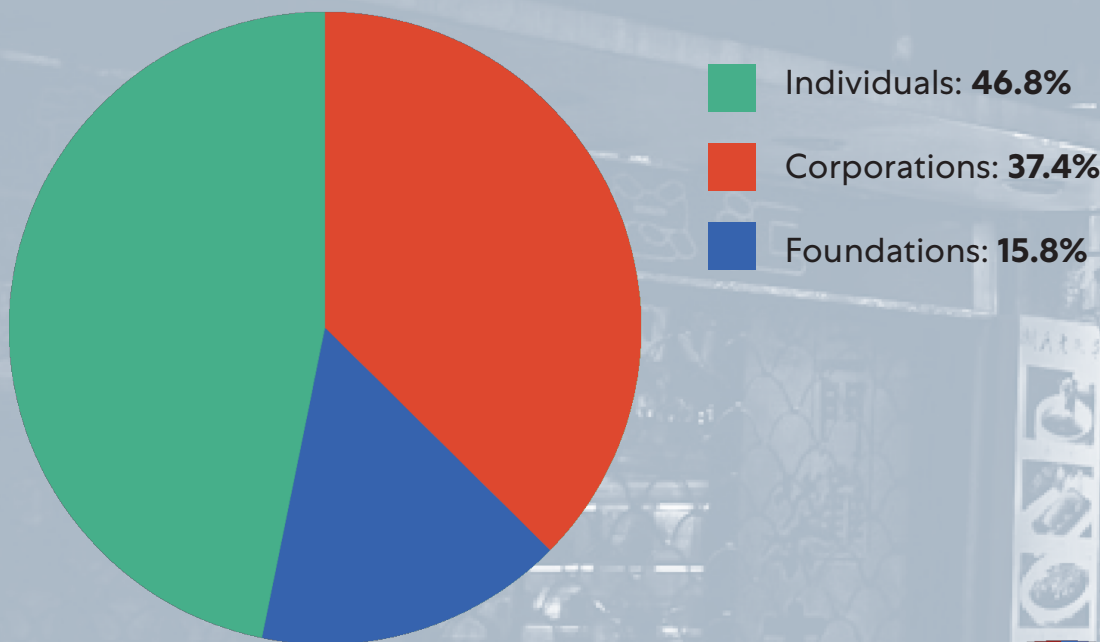

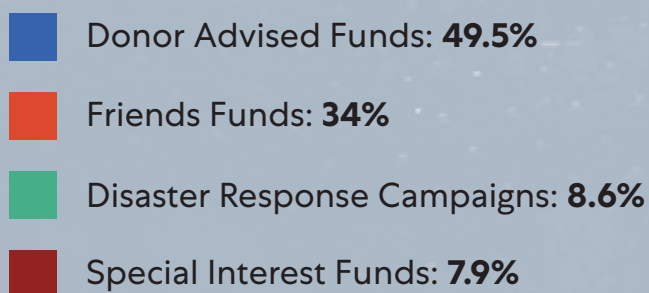
2025 PERFORMANCE & IMPACT SNAPSHOT

In 2025, we received \$29.1 million in contributions from private donors around the globe and granted \$23.8 million for charitable projects across China benefiting 214 community projects.

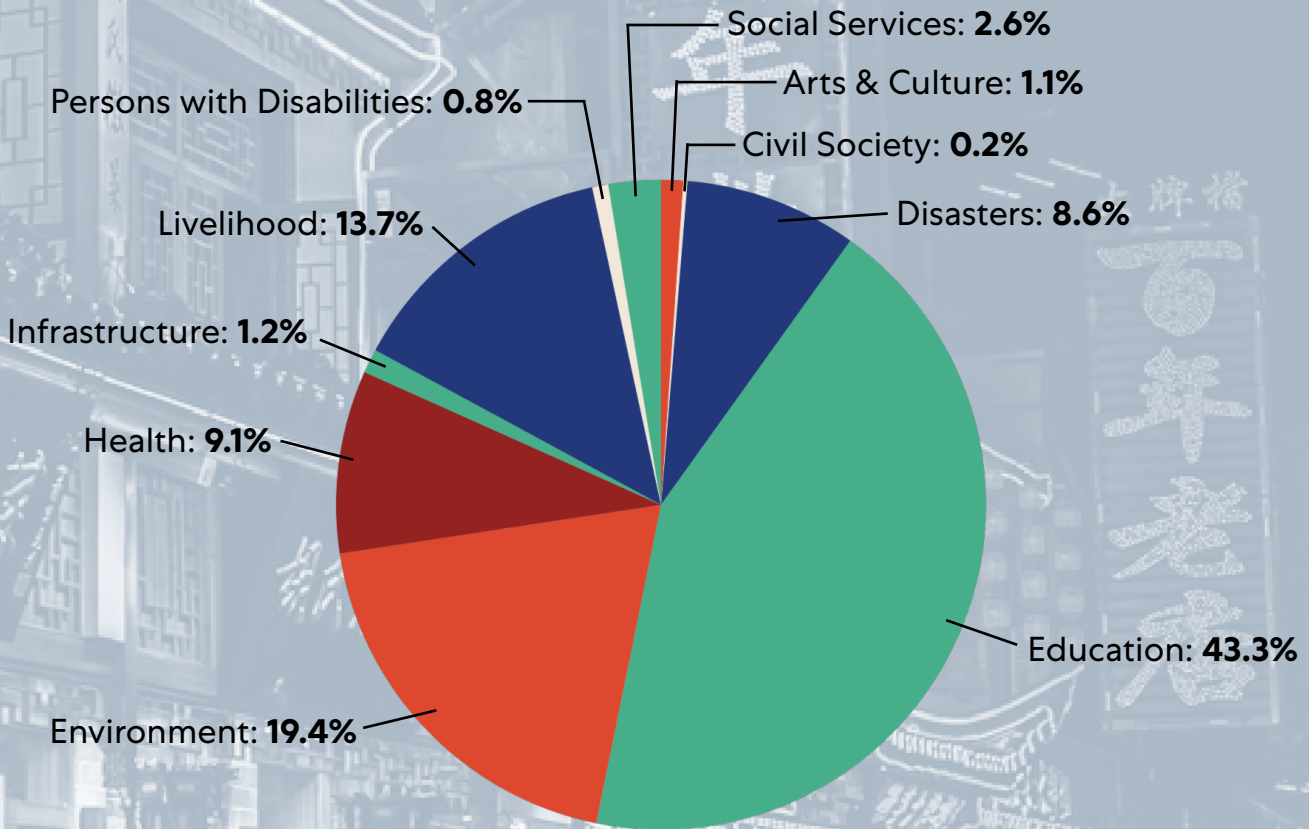
GRANTS BY DONOR TYPE



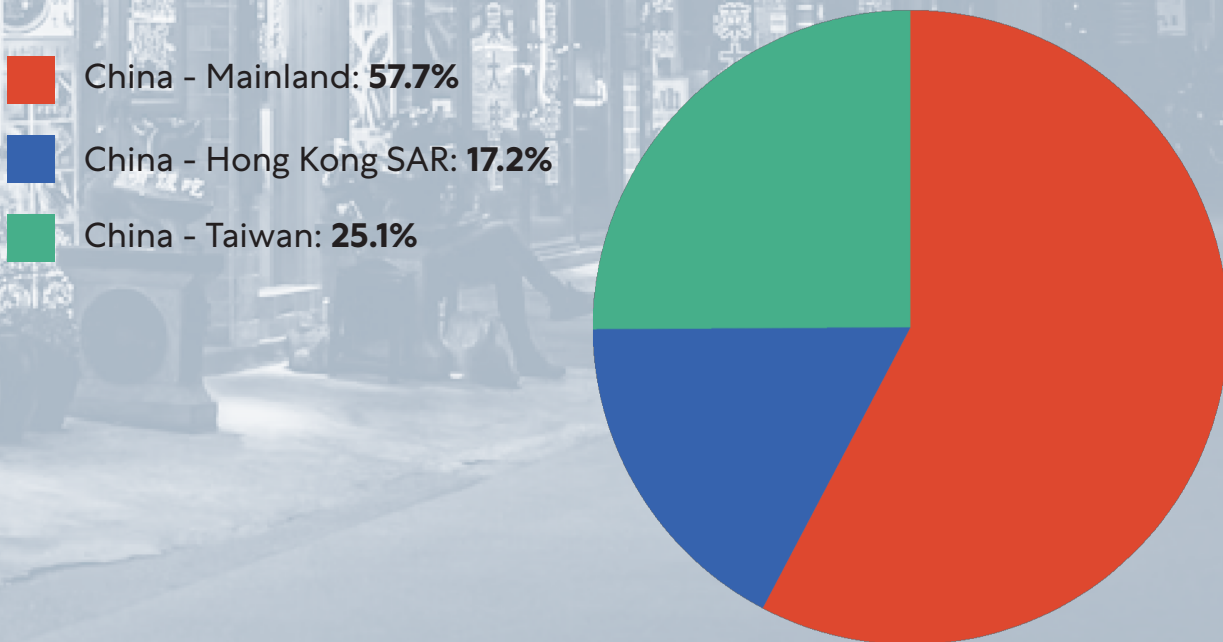
GRANTS BY FUND TYPE

SIGNATURE PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

RURAL HEALTHY FAMILY PROGRAM

Implementing a rural family health management model to improve hypertension control rates among rural residents through various intervention measures and providing health education. The goal is to reduce the incidence of cardiovascular diseases in rural communities.

2025 IMPACT:

- Since its launch in 2024, the program has benefitted 2000 rural families across 40 villages in Ruyang County, Henan Province.
- After several months of intervention, the number of residents with above-standard systolic and diastolic blood pressure was reduced by 22% and 15%, respectively.

TOMORROW-*i*CAN PROGRAM

Empowering high school students from families without any college attendees through educational scholarships and extensive mentoring. Our initiative focuses on enhancing students' academic skills and college readiness, aiming to cultivate the first generation of college graduates in their families.

2025 IMPACT:

- More than 1,300 students supported
- 1,094 students took the National College Entrance Examination in 2025
- To date, 90% of students became first in their families to attend college, and over 60 students gained admission to first-tier universities including Peking University and Tsinghua University.

RURAL DOCTORS TCM TRAINING PROGRAM

Elevating Healthcare in underserved areas through Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM). This initiative bridges the healthcare divide by providing rural doctors with a year-long immersion with TCM experts. We aim to enhance their clinical and diagnostic skills, addressing the critical need for quality TCM in rural settings.

2025 IMPACT:

- Trained 393 rural TCM doctors in Nanchong City, Sichuan Province, enhancing their diagnostic and prescription skills.
- To date, this program has trained over 2,300 rural TCM doctors and benefited over 2.3 million rural residents in China.
